## European Urban Forum for Ukrainian Architecture and Urban Planning Students

We would like to offer Ukrainian architecture and urban planning students a forum for professional exchange, networking and advice on study opportunities in Germany in these difficult times of war.

The aim of the forum is to provide an online meeting place for Ukrainian students who have had to leave their home country or who are currently unable to continue their studies at their universities or who are just interested in this exchange.

We would like to start with a first preliminary meeting to see who is interested and in which areas the interest are. We would like to discuss on which topics you would like to have input, on which topics and work joint consultations or an exchange in a larger group would be useful and in which areas advice and support would be helpful.

Subsequently, weekly online meetings should enable an intensification of the exchange and a programme with corresponding topics should be developed. The focus will be on the future of European cities and the challenges to urban development and renewal.

We propose to hold five dates in May and June, each for about two to three hours. After that we will decide which further joint activities would be useful.
