

# Call for Scholarships Application

## Ukrainian Students in Ukraine and Germany to study Urban Development and Reconstruction from August to December 2022

### Programme

#### What is the framework

Ukrainian students in Ukraine and Germany are invited to apply for the scholarships offered within the framework of the **DAAD Programme Ukraine digital – Ensuring academic success in times of crisis**. In response to the devastating impact of the war from Russia against Ukraine on the infrastructure of the higher education system, this programme focuses on the rapid establishment and implementation of virtual courses.

### Project

#### What is the focus

In 2017 Ukraine incorporated the goals of the EU Leipzig Charter into its own decentralised planning system with the White Paper "Urban Development". Whereas Russia's war of aggression against Ukraine not only targets independent and democratic Ukraine, but also the goals of the EU Leipzig Charter: the European city as a place of democracy, pluralism, rationalism, subsidiarity and common welfare, besides the public space as a place of exchange, free residence and protest. These topics are hence to be studied in depth within the new teaching formats in order to enable a sustainable reconstruction in freedom.

Accordingly, four German universities of TU Kaiserslautern, BTU Cottbus, TH Lübeck and TU Berlin has launched the project of **Digital Learning Platform – ReConstructionModules and Integrated Urban Development** with the funding support of DAAD whereby courses about reconstruction and urban development will be made available and Ukrainian students and academics in need will be supported with scholarships.

### Applicants

#### Who can apply

- Students of urban planning, architecture or similar disciplines related to spatial planning
- Students of Ukrainian universities at planning study programmes who are currently enrolled and attend their studies in presence or online
- Ukrainian students who have fled to Germany as well as students who have continued their studies at one of the German universities

### Commitment

What is expected from you

- Success in your studies
- Participation in a joint seminar or project within the framework of the exchange programme

### Support

What do we offer

- Scholarship funding during the winter semester 2022-23 to:
  - 20 students in Ukraine, each with monthly allowance of 200 € for the period of 6 months
  - 6 Ukrainian master students to study at TU Kaiserslautern or BTU Cottbus, each with one travel allowance and monthly allowance of 861 € for the period of 5 months
- Participation in German-Ukrainian teaching formats and workshops, supervised by selected lecturers and experts
- Professional involvement in project focal points such as reconstruction and inner-city development, implementation of the goals of the Leipzig Charter, integrated urban development, innovative planning instruments, affordable housing, emergency housing
- Efforts will be made to accommodate the study achievements in the context of the ongoing study programme

Your application should include a motivation letter, CV and your portfolio (three best works).
