### Training Workshop for Ukrainian Lecturers

### Integrated Urban Development Planning

### TU Berlin – 5<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> December 2022

#### Call

What is the framework

Ukrainian Lecturers in Ukraine and abroad are invited to apply for the training workshop within the framework of the project **Digital Learning Platform – ReConstructionModules and Integrated Urban Development**. This workshop which is organised by TU Berlin and BTU members of the project will be held at the Institute for Urban and Regional Planning of the TU Berlin from 05<sup>th</sup> until 09<sup>th</sup> of December 2022. The German partners from the TH Lübeck, the BTU Cottbus and the TU Kaiserslautern will participate in the workshop on individual days.

#### Workshop Programme

What is the focus

In this workshop, in addition to the digital offers, the participant lectures will get to know each other personally and exchange ideas. The workshop focuses on integrated urban development planning with five main work packages.

The five topics will be explored and developed on the basis of visits and city walks in Berlin. Every day there will be lectures and seminars in the morning. During the seminars, participants will report on their experiences with urban development in Ukraine and the afternoon will be devoted to visits with teamwork and a concluding colloquium.

The most important goal of the workshop is for the participants to become familiar with the planning steps and contents of integrated urban development planning. For the participating lecturers, the workshop will provide an important consolidation of the topics of the lecture series.

#### Applicants

Who can apply

- Ukrainian lecturers (professors, research assistants, PhD researchers and similar) in Ukraine or abroad working on a planning-related study programme
- Good knowledge of English is of advantage

#### Support

What do we offer

The workshop has the capacity for 20 participants.

Following expenses for each participant will be covered through the DAAD funds:

- Travel allowance, the amount of which depends on your place of residence according to economic travel rate. Please note that the trip to Berlin must be organised individually.

- Daily allowances for 6 days that will cover your accommodation in Berlin. The accommodation will be arranged by workshop team.
