

# Call for Scholarships Application

## Ukrainian Students in Ukraine

### to study Urban Development and Reconstruction

#### from April to July 2023

#### Programme

What is the framework

Ukrainian students staying in Ukraine are invited to apply for the scholarships offered within the framework of the **DAAD Programme “Ukraine digital – Ensuring academic success in times of crisis”**. In response to the devastating impact of the war from Russia against Ukraine on the infrastructure of the higher education system, this programme focuses on the rapid establishment and implementation of virtual courses.

#### Project

What is the focus

In 2017 Ukraine incorporated the goals of the EU Leipzig Charter into its own decentralised planning system with the White Paper “Urban Development”. Whereas Russia’s war of aggression against Ukraine not only targets independent and democratic Ukraine, but also the goals of the EU Leipzig Charter: The European city as a place of democracy, pluralism, rationalism, subsidiarity and common welfare, besides the public space as a place of exchange, free residence and protest. These topics are the framework for the new teaching formats in order to enable a sustainable reconstruction in freedom.

Accordingly, three German universities of RPTU Kaiserslautern, BTU Cottbus-Senftenberg, TU Berlin and TH Lübeck, supported by DAAD, have 2022 started the project of the digital learning platform **ReConstructionModules and integrated urban development**. Special courses on reconstruction and urban development will be offered for Ukrainian students with scholarships. This will be the second semester of the successful cooperation with the Ukrainian partner universities: KNUBA, LPNU, ODABA, KhNAUE, ChNU, PPNU.

#### Applicants

Who can apply?

- Students of urban planning, architecture or similar disciplines related to spatial planning staying in Ukraine, who are currently enrolled and attend their studies in presence or online (students from last call can apply again)
- Bachelor’s students from min. 5 semesters (3. year of study) or master’s students
- Knowledge of English or German at level B2-C1 is expected

### Commitment

What is expected from you

- Success in your studies
- Participation in a joint seminar or project and the lecture series within the framework of the exchange programme

### Support

What do we offer

- Scholarship funding during the summer semester 2023 to:
  - 25 students in Ukraine, each with monthly allowance of 200 €/month for the period of 4 months
- Participation in German-Ukrainian teaching formats and workshops, supervised by selected lecturers and experts
- Professional involvement in project focal points such as reconstruction and inner-city development, implementation of the goals of the Leipzig Charter, integrated urban development, innovative planning instruments
- Support of the recognition of the study marks for the ongoing study programme
